Clothing Room Opening: April 4th from 9:00—12:00. Clothing is free to the public. Volunteers are needed. Please sign-up at the table in the foyer.

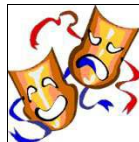
Pre-school Department Teacher's Meeting: Sunday, April 5th at 4:00 pm in 103N. All pre-school teachers are encouraged to attend.
