

THEY HAVE HEARD SCOTLAND CALL AND THEIR ANSWER IS "YES!"



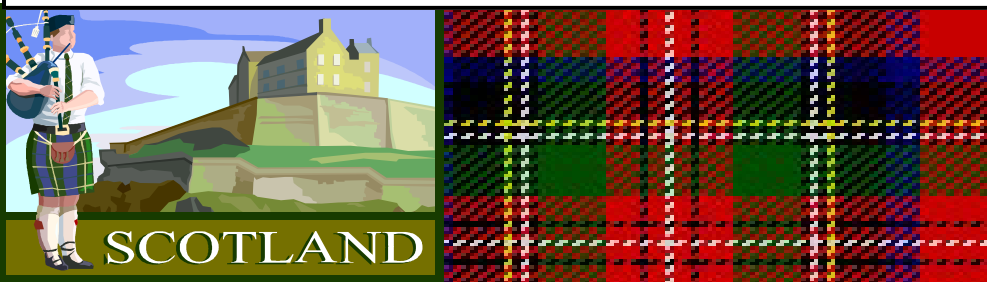
HISTORY...For Denny and Linda Sneed, the dream to serve in Scotland began in 1973, when they graduated from the Sunset School of Preaching in Lubbock, Texas. Alex Strachan, a Scottish classmate, invited them to come at that time. However, the Sneeds were newlyweds and Linda was a new Christian. In 1982, after 9 years of stateside experience, he asked them again to come to Scotland. They struggled unsuccessfully for 2 years to raise support, then decided to return to stateside work. In 1998, they joined the work with the Ukrainian Bible Institute (UBI, a branch of Sunset International Bible Institute) where they worked as fulltime teachers in Donetsk, Ukraine. They worked in Ukraine 5 years before returning to the states and fulltime preaching. In 2006, the call from Scotland came again, a third time; and the dream to work in Scotland was rekindled. After a survey trip in September (2006), they have decided to answer this third call with a resounding "YES" and a prayer.



SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE...Denny is a strong and solid Bible teacher, routinely weaving Bible history into sermons and lessons. He prepares his lessons carefully to be true to the Word and he strives to relate to and meet the needs of the congregation. He is a team worker, leads singing, and serves in whatever capacity he is needed. Denny relates well to those he works with and is well-respected by those in the church and surrounding community. **Linda** has taught women's and children's (all ages) Bible classes for many years. She has been a guest speaker at various workshops because of her innovative teaching methods. While at UBI in Donetsk, Linda taught women's classes and visited local orphanages, presenting Bible lessons. Equal to her love for teaching is her love for the deaf. She has already begun learning British Sign. (While in Ukraine, she learned Russian Sign.) Linda has been a Texas State Certified Interpreter for the Deaf since 1994.



Glenrothes, population of 38,679, is located just an hour north of Scotland's capital city of Edinburgh. The Glenrothes congregation has about 50 members. About half of them are over 60.

- Kim—born 1974, single, working as a missionary in Peterhead, Scotland.
