From Rich Dolan of Cambodia Bible Institute

As I thought about what to write for you, I decided to tell you about some of our students. Many of the others have amazing stories like these, but there is only room for so much.

Sovan has been at our school for 2 years. He will graduate in December. Sovan came to CBI, because Tawn (the man who teaches and translates at CBI) taught him English when he was a child. Through Tawn's influence, Sovan became a Christian. In August of 2008, he started training at CBI, again because his parents knew and trusted Tawn. Following vocational training Sovan plans to work with the new congregation we started at Try and Sokna's village. Sovan is an excellent student who has a great heart for God. I expect good things from him.



Soklee is about 20 years old. He has also been at our school 2 years and will graduate in December. Soklee was one of the quietest, shyest boys I had ever met. When he first started school, he would not look you in the eye when talking with you. That has changed. When he went home a year ago, his older sister asked him, "Who are you? You've changed so much. And, you talk about Jesus all the time!" Soklee's father is the man who calls the monks to prayers in the Buddhist temple. So, Soklee has to go against his family's beliefs. That is difficult and takes a strong faith. Lee plans to work with Chheav, who graduated last December, with another congregation we started close to Phnom Penh. Someday soon, he may be part of a team that goes back to his hometown (about 150 miles away) to start a congregation there. Lee is another great student who has grown so much.

Pisey (Pe-say) will be our first female graduate. She was not a Christian when she started our school. She came with a friend, Rinna, who is a Christian. Rinna's parents forced her to come home after a month, because the grandparents convinced her parents that she should not be around those "Christians". We thought that Pisey would drop out also. Instead, she stayed, became a Christian and has really grown in her faith. She won't say for sure, but I think she has plans to marry one of our preacher students who is out working with a congregation now. Whatever she does, she will be a good influence in the church in Cambodia, which is young, small and weak.



Sokun is a man about 28 years old. He has been at the Cambodia Bible Institute about a year. Formerly, he was the keyboardist and a pastor in a denominational church. He was a friend of Tawn's from their hometown (about 150 miles away). He would often ask Tawn to come preach at their place. Sokun told Tawn, "You always use the Bible and know why you believe." Tawn suggested Sokun come to our school. Sokun did, became a Christian and is a great student with so much potential. He told Tawn the other day, "Now I know what I believe and why I believe it."

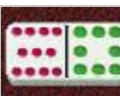
Good Guy Carnival: TONIGHT following evening worship. Middle Schoolers set-up time is 3 pm. **CANDY STILL NEEDED!!**
