While we share a multitude of things in common as brothers and sisters in Christ, no two of us are in precisely the same frame of mind, condition of heart, state of emotion, or set of circumstances today. Unity as Christ's spiritual body does not mean that we are an undifferentiated, monolithic mass of Christians who think, feel, and experience life and faith exactly like everyone else.

Some of us are filled with joy and expectation. Things are going very well in our lives. We are happily employed or happily retired. There is "peace in the valley" in our marital and parental relationships and among our friends. We are in good general health. If that's the case for you, then praise God! Seriously! Stop what you're doing, and praise him and thank him right now. "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and praise his name," (Psalm 100:4).

Some of our hearts are filled with fear and doubt. Faith and doubt coexist in constant tension during our journey in the steps of Jesus. Some days, faith has the upper hand; at other times, doubt appears to be winning the day. If that is the case for you today, freely and openly acknowledge those feelings to the Lord. Ask your Father for help in overcoming your fear and for strength in your struggle with doubt. "I do believe; help my unbelief," (Mark 9:24).

Some of us are feeling anxious, worried, and stressed. We are still seeking a job after an extended period of unemployment, or we're concerned about the stability of our workplace. We are experiencing difficulties in our marriage or strained relationships with other people in our family. Responsibilities just seem to keep piling up on top of us, and we feel increasingly more overwhelmed, further behind, and unable to cope. Lay these burdens before the throne of God. "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God," (Philippians 4:6). "Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you," (I Peter 5:7). Hang on! Keep trusting!

Some of us are hurting today from the physical pain and discomfort of a chronic illness or degenerative disease. Others are extremely weak and feeling totally wiped out because of ongoing cancer treatment. Others are feeling numb and lost because of the recent death of a loved one. May the father of mercies and the God of all comfort grant you peace and strength to endure. May he hasten the day when sorrow and pain will be no more, death will be swallowed up in victory, and his gentle, loving hand will wipe away every tear from our eyes.

May our loving God and Father shower his richest blessings upon each of you today, and may his divine comfort and strength sustain and uplift you according to your specific, individual needs.


CONGREGATIONAL NEWS
